The Grosvenor Hotel

Stockbridge is officially England's 'smallest town', the heart of fly fishing country with the River Test meandering through. Its wide high street was once a drover's road where vast flocks of sheep used to pass through en route from Wales. The Grosvenor sits in pride of place in this pretty Georgian town surrounded by beautiful countryside.



Traditional yet colourful, the hotel has been completely renovated to a very high standard by new owners, Simon and Teresa Henderson, with both the interiors and the fabulous courtyard garden designed by Lottie Keith. The bedrooms each have a warm, individual



character, the food is contemporary and fabulous with excellent reviews. Dogs are very welcome too. StockenBridge in Stockbridge – it's meant to be.

Fine dining at The Grosvenor

We will use two dining areas, the larger River Room and the Library, a private dining room for twelve. Chef Viraj Athukorala came from Clos Maggiore in Covent Garden and is influenced by French cuisine and fine dining. Lunch is not included in the holiday but guests can enjoy a delicious lunch at The Grosvenor or check out local options a short walk away.

At breakfast, a round table groans with fresh fruits, creamy yoghurts and warm pastries; from the extensive cooked menu, order full English, fresh or smoked trout - and more!

Dinner will be accompanied by half a bottle of house wine per person. This is a sample menu and will vary according to the season and availability of produce. There will be a choice of 3 dishes for each course, ordered in advance. Any special diets can be catered for.

Accommodation

The Grosvenor has 31 bedrooms, 18 in the main building plus 13 garden rooms in the annex, one of which is the superb Hayloft Suite. Beautifully styled rooms feature bright modern fabrics, statement headboards, and pretty ceramics. All rooms have delightful en-suite bathrooms most with showers, some with baths and some

both. All rooms have king or super king-sized beds, except the single and 4-poster rooms. Rooms all have television, hairdryer and Nespresso coffee machine.

PLEASE NOTE: The hotel does not have a lift, but none of the stairs are particularly steep and there are handrails. The ground floor garden rooms are accessible and dog-friendly. There are no steps anywhere on the ground floor of the hotel with the exception of one step at the front door where a ramp can be put down.

Other things to do around and about

There are no bridge sessions scheduled for the afternoons, so this would be the perfect time to explore the wonderful local surroundings.

Walking

Less than 100 metres from the hotel, dogs and their owners, walkers and runners can access the 100 acres of Stockbridge Marshes, that sit just behind the High Street and run along the River Test. An area of outstanding natural beauty, the Marshes provide wonderfully easy access to Hampshire's great outdoors.

Head along the wide Georgian High Street to visit the town's galleries, artisan food shops, independent boutique stores and craft shops.



Mottisfont Abbey & Gardens (10 min drive) This National Trust medieval priory with rolling lawns and famous walled rose garden offers something for everyone - woodland walks, art exhibitions, gallery and a shop and plant centre.



Leckford Estate (10 min drive)

The garden and woodland walks are part of the John Lewis Estate, with the Arboretum, Water Garden, farm shop, café and nursery.



Winchester/Salisbury (20 min/30 min drive) Historic cities with wonderful cathedrals.

The tuition sessions will use Compass Cards (set deals) and a fun topic tailored to the group. All bridge sessions are optional and open to all standards of play although we can only accommodate complete beginners if booked as a group of four. Water, tea and coffee will be available during play.





It is important to stress that our holidays are not aimed at the type of player who likes a serious 24-board duplicate every night. Our ethos is that bridge should be a friendly and social game where you can meet like-minded people, and our holidays reflect that. No partner is needed on a StockenBridge holiday.

The Grosvenor Hotel is in the centre of Stockbridge, 10 miles northwest of Winchester in Hampshire.

Travelling by car:
