Travel Details

Jersey is within easy reach of the UK and the continent by air and by sea. The island's compact size and minimal traffic mean that most road journeys take a matter of minutes enabling you to take advantage of the free afternoons to explore.

BY AIR

Jersey is served by over 40 departure points across the British Isles including up to 12 flights a day to the island from London airports, including Gatwick, London City, Southend and Stansted. There are five British Airways flights a day from London Gatwick with a flight time of 1 hour. Easyjet offers an excellent budget option to Jersey from Gatwick and Southend.



Longueville Manor is a 15 minute drive from the airport - we can organise a pick-up (*approx £15 - £18 each way per taxi*) if you are not hiring a car.

BY FERRY

If you wish to bring your car to the island, fast ferry services leave from the south coast of England - sail from Poole or Weymouth with Condor Ferries and you can be in Jersey in less than 4 hours. Alternatively you can take a ferry from St. Malo in France or one of the other Channel Islands.

CAR HIRE

Included in the price of your holiday is group 1 car hire with Avis for the duration of your stay - available to pick up from Jersey Airport.

Excluded in the price - local registration fee and government tax (approx £3/day), insurance (from £10/day depending on the level of insurance you require) and petrol - total cost approximately £38 + petrol for 3 days.
