Hotel Casa da Calcada is a luxurious 5-star hotel, situated on the banks of the River Tamega in the pretty town of Amarante. This restored 16th century palace maintains its original Baroque style with its charming furniture, furnishings and ornamental touches, giving the feel of a family home coupled with high levels of comfort and service.



The hotel is privately-owned and a member of the prestigious hotel group 'Relais and Chateaux' - an exclusive collection of the finest hotels and gourmet

restaurants worldwide. The hotel also has attractive and peaceful gardens with a swimming pool enjoying views over the town of Amarante.

Amarante (right - the hotel is on the right of the photo) is perfectly placed in rolling hills, not far from the historic towns of Porto, Guimaraes and Braga and near two important wine regions. This pretty and bustling riverside town is



one of the gems of northern Portugal featuring rows of 17th-century mansions with brightly painted wooden balconies lining narrow cobbled streets.

Largo do Paco

Casa da Calçada's Largo do Paço Restaurant is justly renowned and has been awarded a Michelin star, the only one in Northern Portugal. Accommodation

The 30 bedrooms and suites are spread out over 4 floors and designed in a classic and elegant style, all with an en-suite marble bathroom. Rooms are all soundproof and come with air conditioning, satellite television, telephone, minibar, bathrobes, slippers, toiletries and complimentary high speed wifi. Some rooms have an extra bed. Most of the bathrooms have a bath with a shower over, though there are three bathrooms with a shower, including one adapted for guests with reduced mobility.

The hotel has a lift serving all floors and there is a ramp to access the garden, swimming pool and bridge room *(on the 4th floor and behind the hotel)*. Zeb Stocken has many years experience of teaching and hosting bridge events, and whether you come as a group, in a pair or on your own, you can be certain of an instructive and enjoyable game adapted to your level.

Claudia – Zeb's sister – will

be on hand to ensure the smooth running of your holiday and, as a keen and experienced bridge player herself, she will also be supervising bridge sessions. The bridge programme will be a mixture of teaching, supervised play and some duplicate - all played in a fun and friendly environment. The tuition sessions will use CompassCards (set deals) and a fun topic tailored to the group.

The other sessions will be supervised play or some form of duplicate, with prizes at the end of the stay. All bridge sessions are optional and open to all standards of play although we can only accommodate complete beginners if booked as a group of four. Water, tea and coffee will be available during play. Non-bridge playing partners are of course welcome.

It is important to stress that our holidays are not aimed at the type of player who likes a serious 24-board duplicate every night. Our ethos is that bridge must be a friendly and social game where you can meet like-minded people, and our holidays reflect that.

Excursions and things to do in the area

We plan to organise two optional excursions during your stay, though a range of trips can be booked through the hotel. We will contact you nearer the time with the exact details and prices, and you will then be able to book these trips in advance. Here are three possibilities:

Day trip to Porto

A fabulous excursion to this thriving and vibrant trading city features a tour of the important historic monuments of the city, a cruise along the Douro River and a visit and wine tasting at the famous Grahams Port Wine Cellar.

Day trip to the Douro wine region

A scenic tour of the fertile and picturesque Douro Valley (*right*), where thousands of terraced vineyards line the steep river banks, starts with a morning visit to the Tedo Wine Estate. Then on to the attractive town of Lamego to see the spectacular Nossa Senhora dos Remedios, a pilgrimage site with a 686-step

stairway up to the chapel with splendid views of the valley below. An afternoon visit to the Seixo Wine estate completes the day with a tour and tasting.

Day trip to the Minho region

Visit Guimares, a UNESCO World Heritage site with its impressive castle and charming medieval centre with artisanal shops and cafes. Then on to





Braga with grand 18th century houses, pretty gardens and churches including the oldest cathedral in the country, before finishing at the Temple of Bom Jesus *(right)*, Portugal's most spectacular religious sanctuary.

<u>Golf</u>

There are various excellent courses within an hour's reach of the hotel including nearby Amarante golf course (*right*) which is varied and challenging and Oporto golf course, founded by British port shippers in 1890, and the oldest in the Iberian peninsular, laid out on sand dunes by the Atlantic.



From the hotel

Amarante itself has plenty to offer with its twice-weekly market and boutique shops. From the hotel gates, cross over the striking arched bridge, Ponte Sao Goncalo, to the main square and pretty cloistered church, and watch the world go by from one of the many riverside cafes. Alternatively, chill out in the gardens, take a dip in the pool or enjoy a relaxing massage at the hotel.

Travel Details

Porto airport is the nearest airport, with a transfer time of 40 minutes. We recommend the British Airways flight from London Gatwick to Porto which has good timings (arriving 18.05 at Porto, departing 18.50 from Porto). We will include airport transfers for anyone on this flight, or any other flights arriving and departing at a similar time. Alternatively Ryanair fly from Stansted and Easyjet fly from Gatwick. We will include transfers for any flight subject to a minimum of six guests. Otherwise transfers cost from 25€ per person each way. Contact us for full details.

If you wish to hire a car, there is a good choice of car hire companies at Porto airport and the route to Amarante is straightforward and mainly on motorways.
